## *Phi Theta Kappa president receives Campus Compact Leadership Award*

Elvis Veliu wasn't expecting to even be considered for the 2025 Campus Compact Student Leadership Award when Phi Theta Kappa Omicron Iota Advisor and Director of Student Activities, Todd Stowell and Erin Stegich, Manager of the Center for Experiential Learning told him he should apply. He was surprised and humbled that they wanted to nominate him.

Last month, Veliu received the news that he was one of six recipients of this year's honor.

The Campus Compact Impact Award was founded in 1985 by a collection of people with the view that America's democracy seemed to be in trouble. Presidents of Brown, Christina Hull Paxson, Georgetown, John J. DeGioia and Stanford, Donald Kennedy; this also included the President of Education of Commission William Bennett. Collectively they believed that higher education would help a better future. It is a celebration of students who are working towards building better communities and making a long lasting impact on campuses.

Students who receive the award lead change on their campuses and in their communities, inspiring their peers to do the same. Recipients of the Student Leadership Award are selected based on their leadership and community impact, ability to overcome adversity, commitment to learning and deep engagement with communities, and support from campus and community partners.

Veliu's goal has always been working

towards bringing community together, even his personal motives are working towards a greater good.

"I really hate not giving my best when I can," said Veliu.

Veliu's goal of building a better community really shines as he explains. When not in class or in PTK meetings, he can be found on campus attending club meetings and campus events.

However, Veliu did take notice early on that student engagement was difficult. He began to make events on or off campus to help bring students together. Sometimes it can be difficult to get engagement up, trying to get students to go do things. Veliu, detailed oriented and dedicated to his work on participating with students, pulled up a list of the hundreds of events he has attended on an excel sheet.

"I'm really working hard to make an impact," said Veliu. He continues to explain that engagement is one of the hurdles to overcome; unsure of where the problem truly starts. Though he does not let that stop him from problem solving.

In his submission to the Campus Compact Impact awards, one question was how do you measure success. Over time, Veliu thought the best way was by hours invested. He began to explain in his essay, what he had done to bring students on or off campus. His idea was to explain how many hours he invested into leading our campus towards change. Veliu put together his ideas such as hiking at local parks and movie nights on campus. This further shows the dedication Veliu shows through action the dedication to solving the mystery

"Schoolcraft College was fortunate to have a leader of Elvis's caliber and seemingly unending energy to help provide encouragement and direction to Phi Theta Kappa members and the community at large."

Veliu and the other recipients of these awards will be recognized at Compact25, Campus Compact's annual conference, which will be held in Atlanta, Georgia from March 31 - April 2, 2025.

During the COVID-19 pandemic, she struggled with low-self esteem, feelings of depression and a recent diagnosis of Tourette syndrome. Lacking confidence, she found it difficult to put herself out there. However, while scrolling through social media, she stumbled upon an advertisement that read,

"You could be the next Miss Michigan Teen USA." Intrigued, yet hesitant, she decided to take a chance and enter the competition.

For three years, Avery competed in the USA pageant system, gradually stepping out of her comfort zone, rebuilding confidence and learning to interact with new people. In 2023, her dedication to pageantry paid off, when she won the title of Miss Michigan Teen USA. This victory reinforced the belief in herself

and introduced her to a diverse and supportive community within a competitive world. One of her favorite aspects of competing is the preparation and the girly nature of everything. From searching for the perfect gown, curating a wardrobe and meeting people from all walks of life, each step fosters anticipation and excitement. Though each

contestant comes from a different background, they are united by a shared passion for pageantry, creating an uplifting and empowering environment.

Hill's most recent and influential pageant was Miss Michigan Collegiate America. This pageant evaluates contestants on multiple aspects, including personality, advocacy and passion. "It seeks participants that can be mentors and have strong beliefs that can advocate for others," said Hill.

For Hill, that cause is Tourette syndrome awareness. Given her personal connection to the condition, she's committed to raising awareness and educating others about what it means to live with Tourette's.

Balancing school, pageants and an active personal life requires a well-structured schedule. Hill maintains a disciplined routine to ensure success in all areas. She emphasized the importance of self-care, and says, "Giving myself one day to decompress and recenter myself really helps me calm down." This practice helps her manage stress, avoid burnout and stay focused on her goals.

Hill's next major competition will take place this year in Little Rock, Arkansas, from June 28 to July 5. Miss Collegiate America is a prestigious event where 200–300 contestants from across the country come

together to compete. The city of Little Rock fully embraces the event, hosting a grand parade and displaying banners throughout the airport and streets. The enthusiasm and support from the community make the experience even more meaningful.

While she continues to compete in pageants, Hill's ultimate dream is to one day win the title of Miss Universe. Representing her country on such a grand stage would be both exhilarating and deeply meaningful. However, beyond titles and crowns, she aspires to make a lasting impact—both at Schoolcraft College and within the broader community.

As someone of mixed race, has an open platform for mental health journey, and is adopted, she strives to be a resource for others who can relate to her experiences. Avery says, "If I can help even one person embrace their identity or overcome personal struggles, I've contributed to a stronger sense of community and belonging."

Winning Miss Michigan Collegiate America was a huge step in Avery's career and re-established her self-esteem. Additionally, she takes great pride in being one of the youngest winners of the Collegiate Michigan pageant. Her journey in pageantry has been about more than just competition—it has

# Connecting the content

*Earth Science professor ties her career history and climate advocacy into the classroom*

Professor Amy Parsons has been an earth science instructor at Schoolcraft College for five years. In her time, she has combined her passion and profound experience to cultivate a classroom that not only fosters learning but builds appreciation for our natural world. Her dedication is exemplified in the indubitable impact she leaves on her students.

Before landing at Schoolcraft, Professor Parsons encountered a diverse range of experiences that deepened her interest in culture and environment. Parsons is originally from Trabuco Canyon, California. She met her husband at UCLA while studying for her Bachelor of Arts. After both having attended Penn State University for graduate school, they decided to settle in his home state of Michigan.

Growing up in California, Parsons has a remarkable perspective into wildfires and their impact on an ecosystem. Recalling many times where her neighborhood was under serious threat of fire, Parsons holds what she describes as an “anecdotal connection”. This distinctive experience opened

an opportunity to study in Brazil.

At Penn State, her advisor’s focus was on fire ecology specific to the Brazilian Amazon, a region not naturally adept to constant burning. Parson’s advisor encouraged her to take her firsthand understanding of wildfires in California and out west, and compare it with recent issues in the Brazilian Amazon. A

significant concern of her research is how species are forced to respond and evolve to the fires. Parsons warns; “We talk about survival of the fittest and if they can’t survive or adapt, then they’re going to be lost.”

As wildfire devastation is not something the rainforest species have dealt with on a regular basis, it becomes increasingly difficult to protect

the environment’s homeostasis.

Deforestation is a current issue that demands attention and action. When asked how to convey this urgency, Parsons contends, “It’s probably one of the biggest challenges of climate change science and advocacy, because it’s so easy to just think

you're disconnected from the problem, and you could go every single day and not really think about how climate change affects you personally."

Connecting to her experience in Brazil, Parsons relays the significance of simplifying complex discoveries, increasing their accessibility to the public and spreading awareness of issues that demand immediate attention.

Despite Parson's deep passion for research and vast experience in the field, teaching is what called to her.

"It wasn't until I really studied a lot more and met other instructors in college that I was like, 'Wait, I want to do what they do, because

it blends not only teaching and helping people, but also teaching the subject that you're really interested in,'" explains Parsons.

Day to day in the classroom, Parsons continues to uphold the importance of each topic utilizing the same methods for climate advocacy she learned in the Amazon. By making connections with a student's own experience, Parsons has learned how to facilitate the critical thinking needed to understand something that is happening thousands of miles away.

To ensure the material's impact, Parsons has learned to approach her teaching through a multitude of ways.

"To me, I have 15 weeks with

my students, and I want to make every moment count. I want to make sure that literally from day one you are making connections with the content and not just being lectured at. [You have] an opportunity to engage with the idea," said Parsons. "I think a big part of it is that I want my students to be more informed citizens about their world and about the environment that they live in."

Parsons' outlook toward teaching includes prioritizing personal connections. She has come to view students as "whole human beings". Beyond her guidance as an earth science instructor, Parsons wants to be seen as a resource as to what might be affecting student's outside of the classroom;

positive or negative. She wants to hear about her student's successes and support them in the challenges that they may face, being a connection to tools available on campus, whether it be personal, academic, or professional.

Parsons emphasizes how her role as a professor at Schoolcraft goes beyond lectures and assignments. She continues to hold the growth of each individual student as a priority and looks forward to what the future holds for her at Schoolcraft.

Currently, Parsons can be found teaching Earth Systems (EARTH 110), Environmental Science (EARTH 120) and Weather and Climate (EARTH 200).

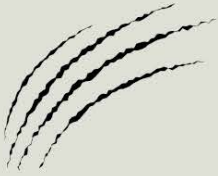

Given the impressive Silent Hill franchises. The "Silent Hill 2" remake has drawn great optimism from developers Konami, the faithful and enhanced revival of this iconic psychological horror game.

The game itself is a landmark of psychological horror, masterfully weaving a tale that transcends traditional gaming narratives. Released on October 8, 2024, this chilling installment allows players to dive deep into the human psyche, which involves the themes of grief, guilt, and existential dread.

Players step into the shoes of James Sunderland, the main character of the game, voiced by Luke Robert, who has been drawn back to the eerie town of Silent Hill after receiving a letter from his deceased wife, Mary Sunderland played by Salóme Gunnarsdóttir. As the player, you will navigate Sunderland through the fog-laden streets, and encounter grotesque monsters that symbolize his inner turmoil. The game has

crafted an atmosphere of relentless tension and unease. With its haunting visuals, immersive sound design, and a memorable story in the gameplay. "Silent Hill 2" has redefined horror and set a new bar for narrative depth and emotional engagement.

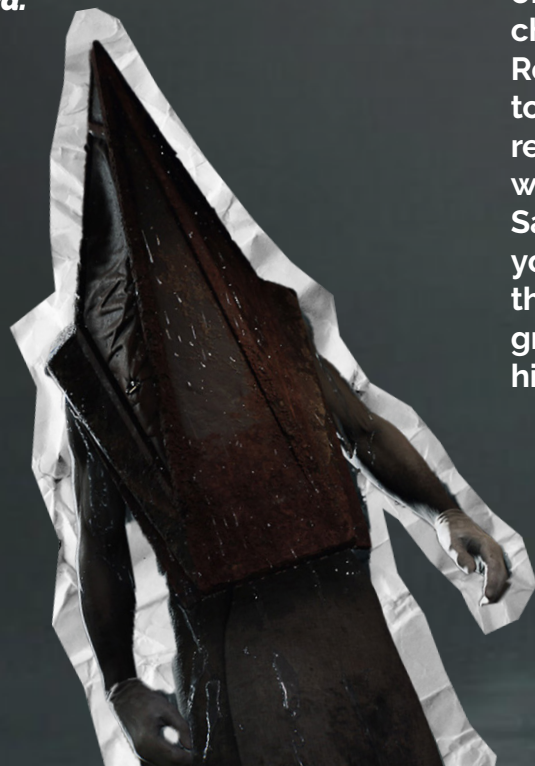
As the game starts, we see Sunderland looking at himself in a mirror, wearing a brown jacket and dark jeans that give off a somewhat rugged appearance. This appearance tells how the death of Sunderland's wife has put him into a downward spiral mentally and physically.

Within this cutscene we see Sunderland calling out his wife's name "Mary," as the scene begins to fade out, cutting to Sunderland looking off into the distance, recalling how his wife always said "that the town of Silent Hill was their special place."

The storytelling is emotional given how complicated and multifaceted the characters that the player will be meaning while playing, but also how they all link up to create their unforgivable relationships that the player will experience time and time


again.

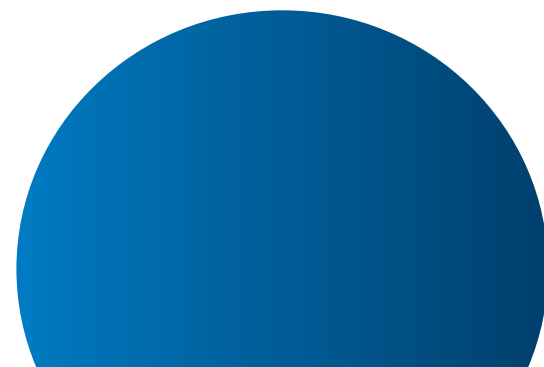
The festival also features the Winter Market, where local artists and businesses showcase their handmade goods.

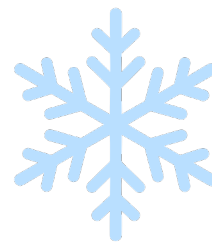
The tubing run features over a 100 feet slide down an inflatable tube. The children were lined up all day long to ride down this slide.

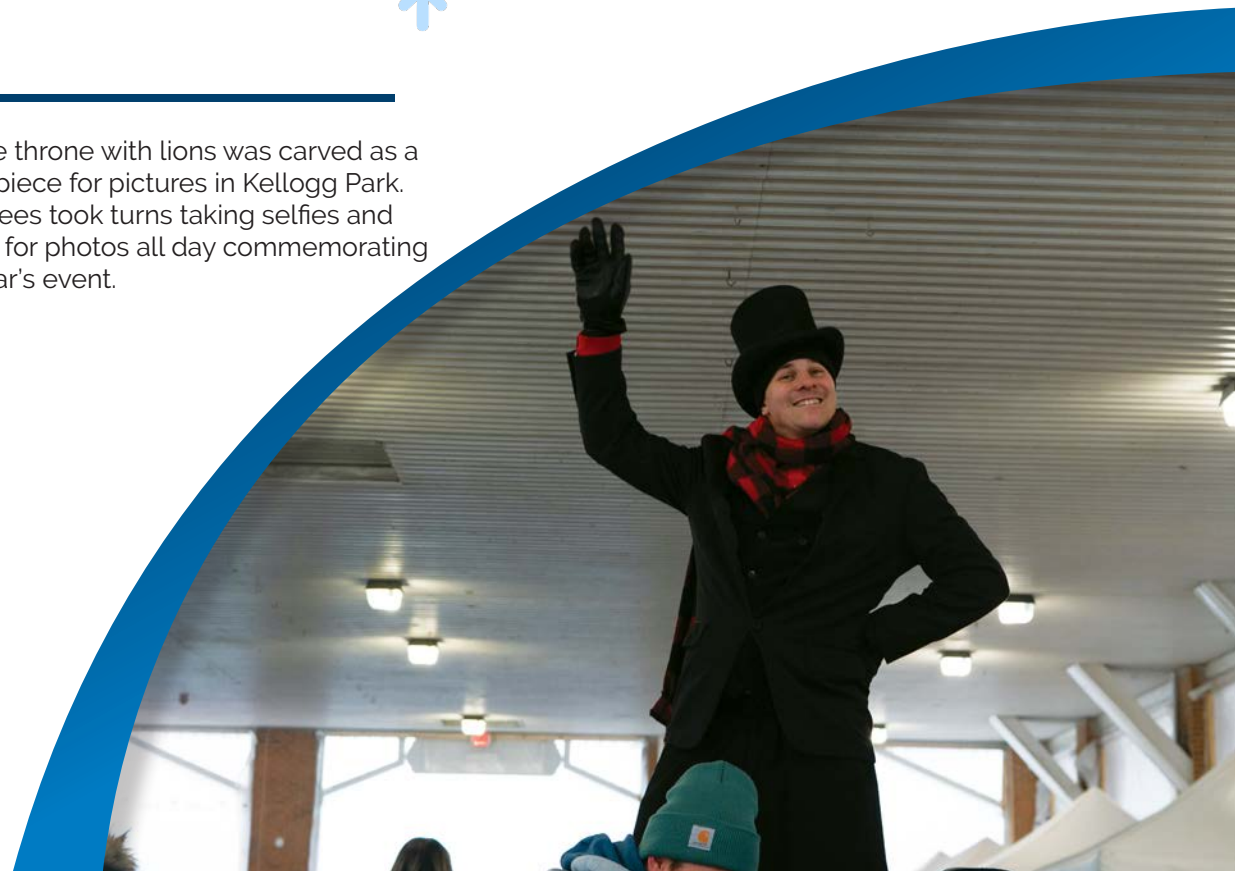

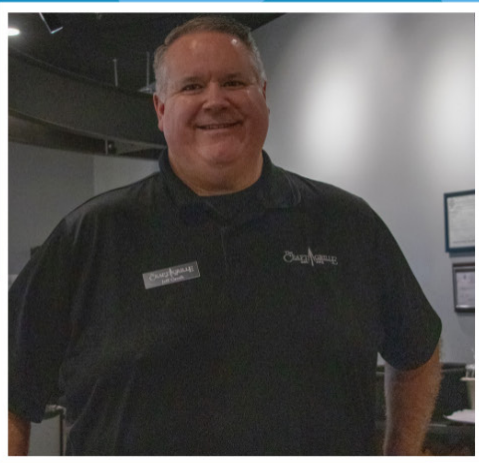

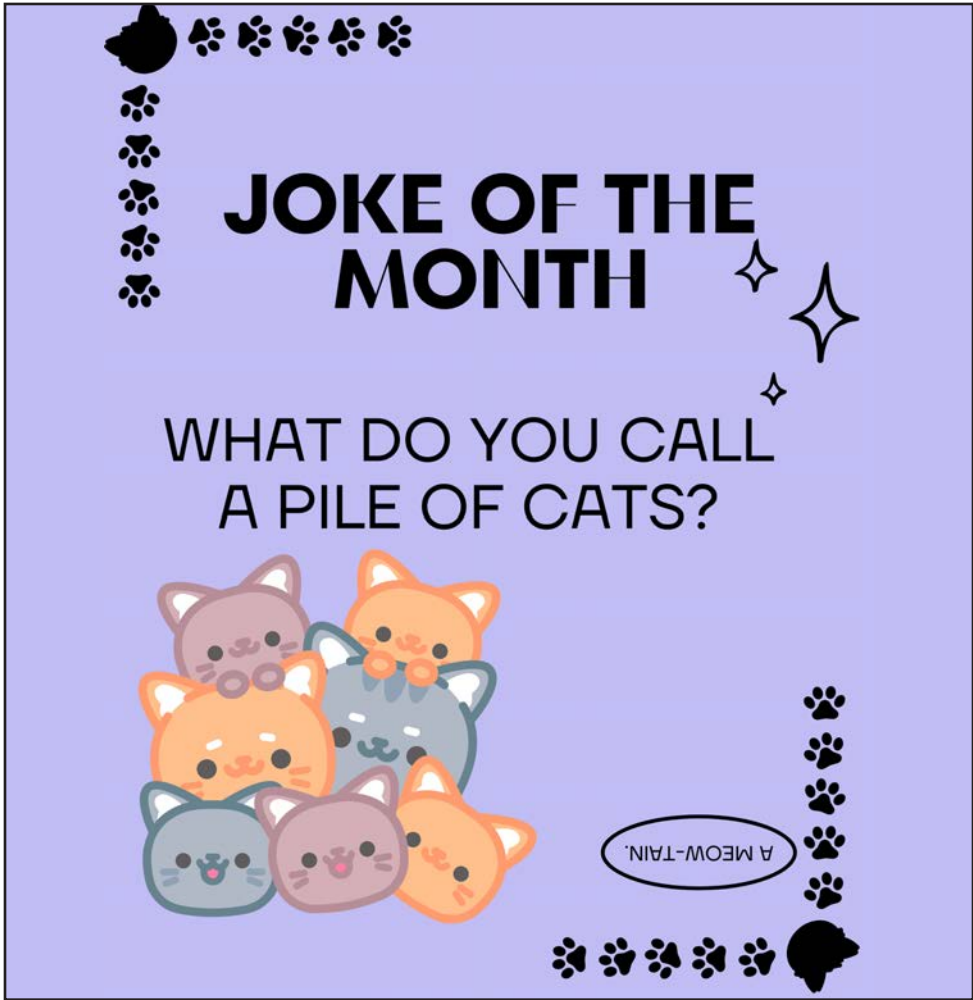
